POLICE DEPARTMENT

Pennsylvania codified a citizen's right to access government records in Act 3 of 2008, called the Right to Know (RTK) Law. The Marple Township Police Department provides open access to the public records of the Agency in accordance with the Right to Know Law. The Agency instituted its Open Records Policy (Marple Police Open Records Policy) to establish procedures in complying with the Act. Citizens need only complete a RTK Request Form to receive a public record. A request may be made in person, by mail, email or fax.
